



#### HELP BETHLEHEM CHRISTIAN FAMILIES

Representatives from Bethlehem Christian Families will be with us on June 17 & 18, 2023 to ask for your help and blessing for the native people of the Holy Land in Bethlehem. These families, sixty vears ago, made up 18% of the population. Recent events in the Middle East have caused these families to face devastating economic strain. The population of Christians has decreased to less than 2% in the Holy Land. These families have relied on the income from selling their hand-carved olive wood religious artifacts. We have come to the USA to help support these families by bringing their artifacts here. All the proceeds from sales will be sent back to the families of the Holy Land so that they may be able to keep their homes and provide for their families. The last few years were very tough for the Christian families, and this is their only source of income.
