

PASTORAL COLUMN

Forgiveness. Even people of faith sometimes struggle with forgiving someone about something they feel is a terrible wrong done to them. What we need to understand that is forgiving means getting rid of the wrong done to us not condoning what was done to us by another.

Moving from such anger and hurt to the hope of forgiveness can be a long process. The anger and hurt that we have can be wholly healed in the process. Some wrongs just seem too hard to forgive but as we move toward forgiving, we are helping ourselves to move on from the wrong. Luke's gospel, 23:34 says, 'Then Jesus said, "Father, forgive them, they know not what they do." Jesus said this while hanging on the cross shortly before he died.

When we pray the Our Father, we say, 'Forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us.' As we look for forgiveness, we have to focus on the process of forgiving others of their sin against us. Today's first reading focuses on our wrath and anger at another while telling that we need to move beyond the injustice if we want to be forgiven by God.

Remember the Our Father, 'AS we forgive those who trespass? You therefore must be perfect as your heavenly Father is perfect; Be merciful as your heavenly Father is merciful (CCC 2842). We are not alone, Jesus is our guide and mentor throughout our lives. Prayer helps.
