

PASTORAL COLUMN

<u>OPINION</u>: We have an opinion about a lot of things but most of the time we don't need to make them public unless we want to. In today's gospel, Jesus asks us all, 'What is your opinion?' and then he shares a parable with us about two sons and which is the one who does what his father asks. Honestly speaking, I always get this wrong because I always make the wrong choice. Luckily for us, Jesus teaches us with parables and explains them as well.

How open are we to changing our minds? Both sons changed their mind in the parable, they do so with no real problem. We are often told to stay in our camps in today's deeply divided political and social climate.

Shouting matches replace civil debate in many pockets of the community. To some, changing one's mind is a sign of weakness or disloyalty. Jesus takes a different stance in today's gospel. The first son willingly changes his mind and does what his father wants.

Jesus celebrates when we change our minds. The one who God greatly exulted, who emptied himself and took the form of a slave out of love for us, longs for us to grow closer to him. Are there areas of your life that could use a change or a different answer? What will it take for such a conversion to happen? Again, prayer helps. The real presence of Jesus in the Eucharist is something to truly believe in.

<u>OPINIÓN</u>: Tenemos una opinión sobre muchas cosas, pero la mayoría de las veces no necesitamos hacerlas públicas a menos que queramos. En el evangelio de hoy, Jesús nos pregunta a todos: "¿Cuál es su opinión?" y luego comparte con nosotros una parábola sobre dos hijos y cuál es el que hace lo que su padre pide. Honestamente hablando, siempre me equivoco porque siempre tomo la decisión equivocada. Por suerte para nosotros, Jesús nos enseña con parábolas y las explica también.

¿Qué tan abiertos estamos a cambiar de opinión? Ambos hijos cambiaron de opinión en la parábola, lo hacen sin ningún problema real. A menudo se nos dice que permanezcamos en nuestros campamentos en el clima político y social profundamente dividido de hoy.

Los gritos reemplazan el debate civil en muchos bolsillos de la comunidad. Para algunos, cambiar de opinión es un signo de debilidad o deslealtad. Jesús toma una postura diferente en el evangelio de hoy. El primer hijo cambia voluntariamente de opinión y hace lo que su padre quiere.
