



PASTORAL COLUMN

This week's opening prayer, first reading, and even part of the psalm speak of hospitality. God is the host, and he invites us to be part of his kingdom. Although he invites us, I feel unworthy and think about ways to change so that I can hope to be included.

John the Baptist in Mark 1:3 says, "Prepare the way of the Lord, make straight his paths." This means I can hope, and I am not alone in needing to change. Jesus says, "This is the time of fulfillment. They Kingdom of God is at hand. Repent and believe in the gospel." Mark 1:15

With these quotes, we can see that as we change to be more Jesus oriented, we are making ourselves able to say, "I shall live in the house of the Lord all the days of my life." Psalm 23:6

The opening prayer gives a good guideline when it says, "Make us always determined to carry out good works."

The first reading helps us understand all the good things that await us in heaven. For example, "the Lord of hosts will provide for all people, will destroy death, wipe away all tears." 


