

On November 1st, All Saints Day, we heard Jesus say, "Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest, says the Lord." Mt 11:28. On November 2^{nd} , All Souls Day, we hear Jesus say, "This is the will of the Father, says the Lord, that everyone who seeks the Son and believes in him may have eternal life." Jn 6:40


