

PASTORAL COLUMN

Each week we are given the opportunity to spend time with God, the Blessed Trinity in adoration. We as Catholics believe in the real presence of Jesus in the Eucharist.

The priest at mass asks the Holy Spirit to change the bread and wine into the body and blood of Jesus. The scholastic term used to designate the unique change from Eucharistic bread and wine into the Body and Blood of Jesus is transubstantiation.

According to the catechism of the Catholic church, adoration is the first act of the virtue of religion. To adore God is to acknowledge him as God, as the creator and savior, the Lord and Master of everything that exists, as infinite and merciful love.

"You shall worship the Lord your God and him only shall you serve," says Jesus citing Deuteronomy 6:4-5


