

TEXT MESSAGE AND EMAIL SCAM ALERT

Father Alan will never request gift cards via text or email. If you have received a text or email that appears to be an urgent message from Father Alan (or other clergy or ACC staff), it is likely an attempt to confuse, manipulate, and steal. You can avoid falling for these scams by educating yourself and other potential recipients. Here are two simple guidelines to help avoid being scammed:

Verify the "From" email / text

The malicious actors are counting on people springing into action as soon as they see an important name on an email. You can avoid their attempt to scam by looking beyond the name and checking the address / number to see if it matches what you know the alleged sender's to be. For an email, you can view the "From" email address by hovering the cursor over the name.

Confirm requests with a conversation

Even if the email or text seems legitimate, if a request seems even remotely "off," don't act on it until you confirm it with a phone call or face-to-face conversation. DO NOT REPLY to suspicious emails or texts.
