

We are now over half way through Lent. Next Sunday on **St. Patrick's Day** we will have our **communal penance service**, at 3:00 at OLV. In the early Church the Irish monks were great promoters of this sacrament... so perhaps it's good timing! At any rate, the sacrament is offered as a special encounter with Christ who heals and forgives and puts us in good spiritual space for Easter. We will have a brief communal prayer followed by the opportunity for individual confession. Two weeks from now, on the Saturday of Palm Sunday weekend, we will have the very special opportunity of a **synodal listening session with Bishop Patrick**. We can all be thinking about our experience of the Church and its ministries and praying for this gathering to be helpful for Bishop Patrick and all present.
