

This weekend we celebrate the Fifth Sunday of Lent! In addition, it is St. Patrick's Day (here's to the Irish!), the St. Elizabeth Men's Group sensational breakfast, AND our ACC Lenten Penance Service. In the midst of all the Lenten activities, central to Lent is the Cross. Central to Holy Week and Easter is the Cross. Central to our faith, our understanding of our spiritual selves is the CROSS of Jesus Christ. I hope you have been or will yet be able to make the Stations of the Cross this Lent (either alone or with the community). To dwell for some time with the reality of Christ's suffering as He carried the cross and then died on it helps us to appreciate the depth of God's love for all humanity...and to unite our crosses with Please feel free to borrow the stations books at church and take them home!
