

### PASTORAL COLUMN

On both Palm Sunday and Good Friday, for the Gospel we proclaim the Passion of the Lord. More than anything else, this sets the tone of our Holy Week. The passion and death of our Lord provide a lense through which we can see all the suffering in our world: the violence and wars, misunderstandings and hatred. Our "why" to the suffering we experience in life is matched by the "why should He have had to suffer"?

The only answer is that this is not God's last word, but that will come in the Easter resurrection with its promise of new life. After our holy Lenten season, let us now use Holy Week to draw even closer to the Lord, deeper into the "Paschal Mystery" which is His suffering, death and resurrection; and to unite our prayers with the whole Christian Church, brothers and sisters around the world. Check the Holy Week schedule carefully; plan to participate as much as you can in the most beautiful celebrations of the Church Year. Have a peaceful, prayerful week.
